


# 2011-2012 Student Occupational Competency Testing Program

## DIRECTIONS TO VIEW APPROVED PROGRAMS

The Pennsylvania Department of Education requires that ALL secondary and adult concentrators in approved career and technical education programs who are anticipated to graduate at the end of the school year, including Tech Prep and special populations students, be tested.


