NOCTI Pre-Tests and Study Guides

NOCTI Pre-Tests are the multiple-choice portion of NOCTI's Job-Ready post-tests and are administered to determine a student's technical knowledge in a career and technical education program.

The following reports are designed to assist instructors and students in **identifying strengths** and **deficit areas** that need further remediation:

Group Score Report
Competency (Task) Reports
Individual Participant Reports

These reports are excellent diagnostic tools to help instructors adjust curriculum to meet the specific needs of students. Targeting the identified curriculum areas for remediation throughout the school year will help to improve student performance on NOCTI post-tests. In addition, the Pre-/Post-Test Comparison Report is a powerful tool that can be used to show individual student improvement and overall program effectiveness.

Why administer a pre-test?

Pre-tests are often used to guide teaching by providing data to:

- · Identify strengths and gap areas
- Target content areas for remediation
- · Assist in making curriculum adjustments
- Offer better and more individualized instruction

Pre-tests provide opportunities for students!

Students are able to:

- Experience NOCTI's online testing system which may help to reduce test anxiety
- Preview the types of questions presented on a post-test
- Recognize their strengths and areas needing improvement

When should a pre-test be administered?

In Pennsylvania, pre-tests are administered at a specific point in the curriculum when there is still time for remediation prior to program completion. CTCs in PA have been using the NOCTI pre-tests as a tool to determine gaps in student knowledge once student data reports are reviewed. The NOCTI Study Guides have been used by CTE instructors for review as well.

How is a pre-test administered?

Pre-tests are administered efficiently using NOCTI's online testing system which provides immediate scores. A proctored environment following NOCTI's administration guidelines is required.
