NOCTI has provided additional documents based on the assessment results for students:

Academic Alignment: **NOCTI Form for Academic Integration**

Integrated Academics reports are now available in a summary format.

Regarding the Integrated Academics Summary Report from the NOCTI website: *NOCTI credentials are designed to assess career-technical competencies. Although the NOCTI credentials are not designed specifically to assess for mathematics, science, and language arts, each typically requires proficiency in these areas. Thus, they measure academic skills in the context of a learner's career-technical program. NOCTI has identified the items in these credentials that require use of knowledge and skills specified by academic standards in language arts, science, and mathematics. This Integrated Academics Summary Report shows, for each academic area, the percentage of items for the credential which were answered correctly by the learners in that group.*

A sample report is provided showing the competencies that are linked with the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, English and Science. This document could be used as part of the process to demonstrate academic integration with the career & technical competencies.

College Credits for Assessment

NOCTI Opportunity for College Credits

Are you aware that students can receive college credits for successful scores on their NOCTI post-test? From the NOCTI website:

“NOCTI collaborates with the National College Credit Recommendation Service (NCCRS) to translate all credential content into college credit. College credit equivalents for applicable NOCTI's credentials NCCRS website. Students who score 70% or higher for approved credentials are eligible for college credit. A free College Credit Recommendation Report is generated for each eligible student and students may also request an official transcript from Excelsior College by completing an application.”

College credit at over 1500 colleges and universities nationally

Transcripted credit availability

Recertification (NOCTI credentials only good for 3 years)

Prior Learning Assessment Credit (for learners who have experience outside of their training)

NOCTI provides the certificate for all students who are eligible to receive the credits. A sample document is provided.

Micro-credentials (Available fall 2021):

The NOCTI website reports: Coming fall 2021, NOCTI's new micro-credentials provide a new learning resource for the CTE community and beyond. Based on nationally validated, industry-based standards and competencies, the content is assembled by CTE teachers with vetted industry experience. These micro-credentials can serve as learning aides, formative assessments, knowledge checks, validation of competence, or as a means of exploring a particular occupation. All learners can benefit from the opportunity to share a credential earned for a targeted set of skills within their occupational program or career path. Micro-credentials can also serve as a resource for asynchronous, hybrid, or synchronous learning whether within traditional CTE, training programs, or for other specialized educational programs and populations.
