www.paact13.net Act 13 training modules: Act 13 of 2020 revised the Act 82 Educator Effectiveness and is taking effect in the 2021-22 school year. There are several important changes in Act 13 such as the Student Learning Objectives (SLO) have been eliminated. The observation portion (Danielson Model) has increased to 70% of the evaluation for teachers for schools with building level data. Now, there is a multiplier that is based on economically disadvantaged students in the district. The higher the EC/Dis numbers, the more the adjustment is made. It is required for all educators participate in the training.
