NOCTI Updates

Mandatory Training for Test Site Coordinators

Join PDE, NOCTI, and ERC representatives as they cover what you need to know before post-testing and answer your burning questions. Topics will include what you are responsible for during testing, how to determine if a student should be tested, how to add accommodations for a student, how to protect yourself and your school in the event of a security violation, and more.

If you do not attend the session and participate actively in the discussion/quiz modules, you will be required to complete another training at a later date before your school will be permitted to order tests.

Pre-Apprenticeship Webinars

The Education Resource Center is partnering with the Bureau of Career and Technical Education and the PA Department of Labor and Industry's Apprenticeship and Training Office to provide more support to schools who wish to offer pre-apprenticeship opportunities for their students. As part of this multi-faceted project, we will be convening a community of practice group virtually in 2026 so that schools can learn more from one another about how to operationalize successful pre-apprenticeship models that lead to careers and postsecondary success for their students. Convenings are expected to occur quarterly throughout the year over Zoom.

PRLAEF Scholarship Opportunity

College is expensive. The PRLAEF can help.

The Pennsylvania Restaurant & Lodging Association Educational Foundation Scholarship Program is accepting applications from students who are pursuing post-secondary opportunities in culinary arts and hospitality management programs until April 1, 2026. This year, the PRLAEF will award multiple scholarships equaling \$2,000 each.

Visit PRLA.org for eligibility criteria and application requirements. While the scholarship is not recurring, previous PRLAEF scholarship recipients are eligible to re-apply.

If you have already started your application, please be sure to log in and check your status. Ensure all fields are complete and supporting materials have been properly uploaded. Only completed applications will be considered by the review committee.

Since 2004, the PRLAEF has awarded nearly \$550,000 in scholarships to students like you.

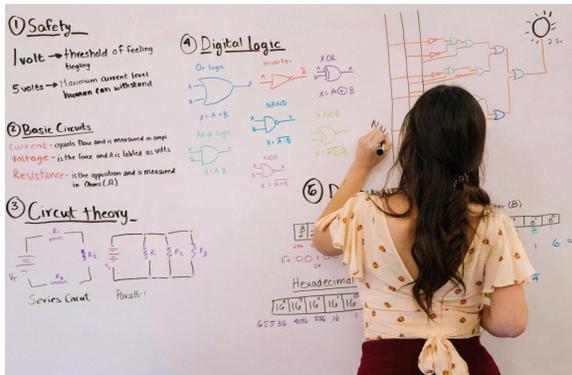
